(P20)

- ◆ 15 years or older
- ◆ Completed 9 years of education
- ◆ Living in Miyagi Prefecture together with their family on April 1, 2022

# Application documents of students who have come from overseas

(P13)

- ◆ Consult with your junior high school teacher
- ◆ Students who come to Japan for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of junior high school only need grades for that 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- ◆ Students who graduated from junior high school before coming to Japan are required to have a graduation certificate and academic grade transcript from their home country

- ◆ The school cannot be changed after application.
- ◆ If you pass, you must enroll at that school.

June : Open Day

July : 3-way interview  
(student + parent + homeroom teacher)

December : Orientation for students from other prefectures

February : First application submission

March : First Application Examination

April : High school enrollment

# Private High School Entrance Examinations

(P4)

**2 private high schools can be applied to.**

## **Exclusive Application System (*Sengan*)**

- ◆ It is easier to enter high school through exclusive application than ordinary application.
- ◆ Examinations are done for a high school which must be your first choice.
- ◆ You must enroll at that school if you pass the examination.
- ◆ You cannot apply at a public school after passing through exclusive application.
